



Bovine 26 Capsule

Bovine 26 Capsules are designed to provide the supportive measures a freshening cow needs to make that transition smoothly and without complications. Dairy cows should be given one capsule 30 days prior to freshening and one capsule on the day she freshens. One capsule also can be given to cows who have been exposed to disease, go off feed, have calved, been hauled or after drug therapy.

Overview

As a Dairyman you know the challenges a freshening cow faces. Loss of appetite, milk fever and ketosis are just a few. We believe that prevention of a problem is best, and that's why every cow needs a Bovine 26 Capsule. We recommend that every cow receives one capsule 30 days before freshening and on the day she freshens. In cows that have a history of Milk Fever or Ketosis, an additional Bovine 26 Capsule every day for the next three days is recommended. Bovine 26 Capsules are not just for freshening cows. They can also be used anytime in a lactating cow's life where she loses her appetite. Most appetite problems are linked to an imbalance in the microflora in the cow's stomach or intestinal tract. Bovine 26 Capsules are designed to help maintain a proper balance and keep a cow on feed and eating properly. We recommend that a Bovine 26 Capsule be used immediately when a loss of appetite is noticed and repeated every 24 hours until the problem is solved.
